F.E.R.A.

Federal Emergency Relief
Administration
(temporary food & money relief)

W.P.A.

Works Progress Administration
built roads, schools, hospitals with
money raised by increasing taxes
on wealthy

C.C.C.

Civilian Conservation Corps
young men in national forests
the “tree army”

A.A.A.

Agricultural Adjustment Act
paid farmers not to plant

N.R.A.

National Recovery Administration
government program that controlled
businesses

F.D.I.C.

**Federal Deposit
Insurance Corporation
protects each bank account up to
\$250,000**

S.E.C.

Securities
&
Exchange Commission
built to watch stock market for
illegal activities

T.V.A.

The Tennessee Valley Authority
built hydroelectric dams.
